



V.V.G.A. STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

Bairnsdale Golf Club - October 2nd. & 3rd. 2017.



CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS:

All Entry Fees to be paid at the time of Entry.

The Council of the VVGA shall have the entire management of the Tournament, including handicapping with the power to alter handicaps at any time during the course of the Tournament.

All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrew and any modifications therefore set out in the local rules of the Bairnsdale Golf Club.

The Match Committee of the VVGA shall have the power to deal with, and determine, any disputes or protests which must be lodged with the VVGA Secretary within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the days play.

The Match Committee decision is final.

The Council of the VVGA may, in event of adverse weather or any other reason, either shorten any event or fix another day and in the case of ties shall decide the manner in which a decision shall be reached.

Entry fees will not be refunded when a scratching occurs less than 14 days prior to the Tournament.

In the event of a tie in the gross event a sudden death play off will take place.

The nett event will be determined by a count back.

To be eligible, players must have a GA handicap, and be member of a Veteran's District.

In the event of suspension of play for dangerous situations, players MUST cease play immediately (marking the position of their ball).

Penalty for breach of condition — disqualification.

Suspension of play will be signified by continuous siren sound.

Range finding devices may be used at all VVGA events.

- Competitors may only receive one trophy per day.
- Trophy winners are eliminated from the Ball competition.
- There is no count back for the Ball competition.
- Nearest the Pins on par 3's for all players i.e. no Grades to apply.
